

New Amendment (7.04(E))

7.04: TERM OF A BoT MEMBER

- A. Every BoT member, other than the immediate past president, is elected for a 2-year term.
- B. The Immediate Past President shall serve in the BoT for only one EC term, per Section 8.04 of these Bylaws.
- C. No BoT member can serve a third consecutive term.
- D. There shall be a gap of at least one year after two consecutive terms
- E. Whereas the COVID-19 pandemic severely impacted the work of the BoT in 2020:
 - a. 7.04(A) shall not apply to those members of the BoT who served in 2020. Instead, each member's term shall be extended by one year beyond the date at which it was scheduled to end, after which the aforementioned section will once again apply.
 - b. 7.04(B) shall not apply to that Immediate Past President who served as an ex-officio member of the BoT in 2020. Instead, his term shall be extended by one year beyond when it was scheduled to end, after which the aforementioned section will once again apply.

New Amendment (8.04(C))

8.04: TERM OF AN EC MEMBER

- A. An EC member is elected for a 1-year term.
- B. No EC member can serve two consecutive terms in the same position.
- C. Whereas the COVID-19 pandemic severely impacted the work of the 2020-2021 Executive Committee:
 - a. 8.04(A) and 8.04(B) shall be suspended during the 2021-2022 EC term.
 - b. The members of the 2020-2021 EC shall serve for one additional year (2021-2022), after which the aforementioned sections will once again apply.
